

Where do your \$38 Metropolitan Local Masters Swim Committee Inc. annual registration dues go?

The \$25 to USMS is for:

- >\$8 Masters Swimming magazine
- >\$5 Insurance premiums to protect our programs, you the swimmer, coaches and officers.
- >\$4 covers the cost of operating and maintaining the USMS national website (www.usms.org)
- >\$8 goes toward USMS national office staff and operations, national committees, conventions and national events, in addition to costs associated with international swimming community relations.

The \$13 that remains in our swim region (LMSC) is applied as follows:

- >\$3.50 per swimmer registration costs (registrar, postage, printing, office supplies)
- >\$1.50 Metro LMSC website expenses (www.metroswim.org)
- >\$2.00 necessary insurance costs to protect registered members, officers and clubs.
- >\$2.40 covers expenses associated with our LMSC obligation to send four (4) voting delegates to the annual USMS national convention to represent your interests.
- >\$0.90 for database services for swimmers, teams, coaches and occasional electronic info transmissions.
- >\$1.85 covers expenses (postage, telephone, internet, local travel, storage, office supplies, etc.) that our elected officers, committee chairpersons and appointees incur to administrate our organization
- >\$0.85 goes toward sanctioned events and LMSC meetings.

LMSC / USMS Stats At A Glance:

- >Metro has about 1,700 registered swimmers
- >There are 12 different Clubs in Metro
- >More than two dozen workout groups or teams are registered with and compete under the Metro All-Star Team umbrella
- >Three of our local Clubs or workout group teams have over 200 members
- >We have over 200 unattached swimmers
- >Metro is the sixth largest LMSC
- >USMS has about 48,000 registered members
